Polls Open: 7:00 a.m. • Polls Close: 7:00 p.m.

Park County residents may register to vote through August 1, 2016 at the Park County Court House in Cody, Powell City Hall, or Meeteetse Town Hall.

Voters may vote at their designated polling places. Voters may also register at the polling place (with proper identification) if needed on August 16, 2016.

Voters who are impaired in any way may choose to use the ES&S Auto-MARK computer to complete their ballot. All polling locations are ADA compliant for your convenience.

To request an Absentee Ballot you must be a currently registered voter and may call the Elections Office at 307-527-8620 or 1-800-786-2844 ext. #8620, or stop by the office in the Court House at 1002 Sheridan Ave., Cody, WY 82414. Absentee Ballot applications are also available online at www.park-county.us/PCElections/index.html and can be mailed to the Elections Office. Absentee Ballots will be available through August 15, 2016. Ballots must be returned to the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on August 16, 2016.
