3. UW College of Agriculture. Use Agriculture College Scholarship.

ELLA E. SCHLOREDT SCHOLARSHIP
DUE IN STATE 4-H OFFICE, FEBRUARY 16, 2007

(Use 4-H Application to apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant may be a graduating high school senior or a continuing student attending the University of Wyoming. (Continuing means: transfer from a Wyoming Junior College or continuing students who have never received the scholarship before.)

Number of scholarships will vary and the amount will vary. Recipients are eligible to renew this scholarship for remaining 3 years at UW based on academic progress. Students need to renew through UW Financial Aid for subsequent years.

SELECTION:

“Scholarships to be awarded to worthy and deserving rural youth who have shown an interest in 4-H work, FFA, forestry work, or other similar lines of endeavor.”

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Each county may submit one or more applicants. For graduating senior and first-time applicants please use the “Wyoming 4-H Scholarship Application Form” available from the state 4-H office, or website (www.wyoming4h.org) and submit to the state 4-H office.

For renewal of scholarship, please apply directly through UW Student Financial Aid office.

For additional information, please review thoroughly the current “Student Financial Aid and Scholarships at Wyoming Colleges’ Bulletin.”

The state 4-H office in cooperation with UW Student Financial Aid will make the selections for the Schloredt scholarship recipients from graduating seniors and first-time applicants only. All renewals will be handled through UW Student Financial Aid office.

UW Student Financial Aid will notify recipients.

When you register, your scholarship money will automatically be credited to your account, this amount will be subtracted in the following order: tuition, fees, and housing – you will pay any remainder.

40% on scholastic record (GPA, rank in class, ACT score)

30% on 4-H work

15% on financial need

15% on character and leadership

**MARJORIE J. GORMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
DUE IN STATE 4-H OFFICE, FEBRUARY 16, 2007**

(Use 4-H Application to apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a Wyoming 4-H member

Members must have been enrolled in any 4-H Family and Consumer Science project and have three years of 4-H work. Indicate on your scholarship form.

Must be a graduating high school senior.

Must be planning to attend the University of Wyoming or any of Wyoming's Community Colleges.

Recipients may re-apply in following years. Previous winners will not receive preferential consideration.

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

On scholarship will be given.

The amount will vary.

SELECTION:

40% on scholastic record

30% on 4-H work and leadership

15% on character and leadership

15% on financial need

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Each county may submit one or more applicants. Applicants should use the Wyoming 4-H Scholarship Application form available at the state 4-H office.

The scholarship is offered as a memorial to Marjorie J. Gorman by her daughter Jewell Vermilyea.

**JANIE SMITH MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP
DUE IN THE STATE 4-H OFFICE, FEBRUARY 16, 2007**

(Use 4-H Application to apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a current Wyoming 4-H member in Laramie County and a Wyoming resident.

Must be a graduating high school senior who will be attending the University of Wyoming.

Recipients may receive the award annually for up to four years, however, they must re-apply with the next year's applicants. (4-H application will be required.)

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

One scholarship will be given in the amount of at least \$600.00

SELECTION:

50% on overall work in 4-H

20% on scholastic standing

20% on citizenship

10% on financial need

(Use 4-H Application to apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a current Wyoming 4-H member.

Must be a graduating high school senior who will be attending the University of Wyoming.

One scholarship will be given

Amount of scholarship will vary.

SELECTION:

40% on overall work in 4-H

30% on scholastic standing

15% on citizenship

Must be a graduating high school senior.

Applicant must be planning to attend the University of Wyoming, or any Wyoming Community College. Preference is given to students going to the University of Wyoming.

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

One annual scholarship provided at beginning of academic year in amount of \$250.00.

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a Wyoming 4-H member.

One for the University of Wyoming or Wyoming Community Colleges in the amount of \$500.00.

SELECTION:

- 40% on scholastic standing
- 30% on 4-H work
- 15% on character and leadership
- 15% on financial need.

40% on scholastic standing

(Use 4-H Application to apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a current Wyoming 4-H member in Washakie County and a Wyoming resident.

Must be a graduating high school senior who will be attending the University of Wyoming and planning to enroll in the Family and Consumer Science or Range Management field.

Recipients may receive the award annually for up to four years, however, they must re-apply with the next year's applicants. (4-H application will be required.)

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

One scholarship will be given in the amount of \$300.00

SELECTION:

50% on overall work in 4-H

20% on scholastic standing

20% on citizenship

10% on financial need

F.A.I.R. POSSE SCHOLARSHIP
DUE IN STATE 4-H OFFICE, FEBRUARY 16, 2007
(Use 4-H Application to Apply)

ELIGIBILITY:

Preference to be given to applicants desiring to major in agricultural and/or natural resource or consumer education.

Must be a current Wyoming 4-H member.

Have been an active exhibitor/participant in the Wyoming State Fair.

Provide a letter or written statement from:

High School Principal – verifying qualifications

Extension 4-H Agent – verifying State Fair participation and specific year(s) of participation

Must attend an accredited college or University in Wyoming.

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

One one-time scholarship will be given in the amount of \$500.00

SELECTION:

Selection to be done by the F.A.I.R. Posse in a manner consistent with other scholarship selection procedures.

UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING, COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE
DUE FEBRUARY 1, 2007

There are about 100 College of Agriculture Scholarships (in all departments) including 15-20 available to incoming freshmen. They are available to all Wyoming 4-H members. In order to qualify for one of these scholarships the student must be:

1. Planning to enroll in the College of Agriculture.
2. Possess a quality GPA and ACT score.
3. Active in school and community activities.

Letters of recommendation are also appreciated, but not necessary.

In addition to the scholarship, all award winners along with their parents will be the guests of the college at the annual "Brand of Excellence" scholarship banquet held in April.
