Wyoming State 4-H Co-Owned Dog Agreement

I certify that I have allowed _____ a 4-H member, the use of the foregoing described dog for his/her use in the 4-H Dog Project. I also certify that the following stipulations concerning the co-ownership have been complied with.

- A. The 4-H member is to have 100 percent (100%) control of the dog which includes sole training, care, and showing of the dog for the current year that he/she is carrying the project.
- B. There shall have been no prior training other than house breaking and no professional training of the dog.
- C. The co-ownership must be completed before April 29th of the current 4-H year. The other co-owner may not show or train the dog during the year it is co-owned,
- D. Any infractions, as determined by a county grievance, review committee, or county 4-H committee, will disqualify said co-owned dog (during year) from showing or competing in any county or state 4-H contest.
- E. This State 4-H Dog Co-Ownership Agreement would be kept on file at the University Extension Educator's office. If required by the county, this agreement should be notarized below.
